Area Participation Needed for Next Phase Beginning October 16th

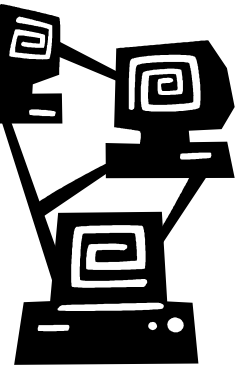
BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In prior phases, the WSO provided oversight of and served as a resource to **Web Talk** Sponsors by verifying that their Al-Anon Member Involved in Alateen Service (AMIAS) certification status was active and by providing suggestions, when appropriate, regarding the posting of Alateen sharings. The WSO also provided technical support to Sponsors and made modifications to the **Web Talk** program when and as needed.

REQUEST FOR AREA ASSISTANCE:

In this next phase which begins on October 16th, we are asking that an Area volunteer to provide Sponsors for **Web Talk** and to respond to Alateen-related Sponsor needs, just as the Area would for any face-to-face meeting. **Web Talk** Sponsors must be currently certified as an Al-Anon Member Involved in Alateen Service (AMIAS) in the Area. Sponsors can reside in other Areas; however, they must also be certified in the Area providing oversight. To do that, they must first be certified in the Area in which they reside. Please contact the WSO if you have any questions regarding Sponsor certification in two Areas or would like additional information. The WSO will continue to provide technical assistance for the program.
