Alternate Delegate's Report

Happy New Year everyone! My name is Heather Paret and I am your Ontario South Alternate Delegate. Much more than that, I am a very grateful member of this world- wide fellowship of Al-Anon/Alateen Family Groups. You may disagree with me if you wish, but I happen to think I have the best home group in the Love and Hope Angus AFG.

Well, the second year of this term is over, the comfortable year. It has been wonderful to reflect on 2010 and all the blessings I have received through using the tools of Al-Anon and getting to know many more members in our Area.

This year is what is called the "Competent" year. That being said, I continue to work on the Area Policy and Guideline Manual using baby steps so as not to get confused by how one change in one section gets carried through other sections of the manual.

In my District #1, I am hoping that the co-coordinators at the Area level will be able to come to our district meetings and share with our district counterparts and GRs all the resources that are available to our members.

On a note to wrap up loose ends from 2010, I would like to share with the Area, the response to the most frequently asked question regarding *The Forum*. The question most frequently asked is in regards to the timing of when groups and individual members receive their copies of *The Forum*. Below is the response from WSO:

"The way we mail The Forum hasn't changed in 8 or 9 years with one exception. Our mailer here in Virginia Beach usually gets the subscriptions out around the 23rd of each month. The group copy is processed 3 or 4 days later. Processing the group copy 3 or 4 days after the subscriptions have been processed is the only change. The mail leaves Virginia Beach by way of a vendor. It gets to the border in approximately 2 days where it is dropped into the Canadian mail system. So, on average, the subscriptions reach the Canadian border and are placed into the Canadian mail system around the 25th or 26th of the month. As an example: the May issue will leave Virginia Beach around April 23rd, arrive at the Canadian border around the 25th and of course, we don't know how long it will take to reach its destination once the mail is in the Canadian mail system. Occasionally, the group copy takes longer to process and therefore, will be later than usual."

May your 2011 be filled with an abundance of Serenity, One Day At A Time. Thank you all for allowing me to serve as your Alternate Delegate.

Chairperson's Report

The next Ontario South Assembly (OSA) Executive meeting is being held February 18 – 19, 2011. The OSA Executive consists of Delegate, Alternate Delegate, Secretary, Treasurer, Chairperson, and 2 Advisors. These are the positions that you, as members, will be voting for at this year Assembly, October 28-30, 2011.

At our Executive meetings we discuss various issues. Some of them include items that were submitted via Items for Consideration at either AWSC or Assembly, items that our Executive received via emails, items regarding the upcoming AWSC meeting May 27-29, 2011, and several other items that have been brought to our attention by members like yourself.

"SECTION 10: FORMS and Miscellaneous ASSEMBLY BID FORM

Background:

A District considering the submission of an Assembly Bid begins by deciding which hotels within the District appear to have the facilities available and capable of meeting the Assembly requirements. The date of the Assembly has normally fallen in the last half of October or the first week of November. The bid must be submitted by the District Representative to the Chairperson, Ontario South Assembly, **NOT LATER THAN May 1st of the year prior to the Assembly date**. In addition, a bidding District must be prepared to present their bid at AWSC. The OSA Executive selects the Assembly site."

This excerpt from our OSA Area 86 Policy & Guidelines Manual indicates that those hoping to host our 2012 Assembly will need to begin searching out possible hotel sites. I look forward to receiving your bids in the near future. Remember "You never have to do anything in Al-Anon yourself". There are many of us who would gladly give you a helping hand regarding hosting Assembly.

The Sam re-certification process is in mid-stream at this time and I have been in close communications with an awful lot of SAMs this year. With the necessity of obtaining Police Record Checks (PRC) for caregivers of Vulnerable Individuals, the workload for all of us SAMs has increased immensely. I thank each and every one of you for your dedication and patience with the process and my timetable. The March 1st deadline is still in place but this year it will be extremely flexible since the in-depth PRC is requiring much more time for the Police to respond to.
